(Public Works) -Full-time Laborer

Job Description

Summary: A Laborer is responsible for performing a full range of basic tasks in construction, maintenance, and repair of the City's roadsides, roadways, bridges, and other city facilities, and may be required to operate and maintain mechanical equipment, and support as a helper larger and more complex equipment. Laborer must be able to follow directions from the Superintendent, Foreman, or an employee of a higher grade level.

Requirements: In order to effectively perform the tasks required to maintain streets, parks, and building maintenance, the incumbent must:

- 1. Possess a High School or Vocational School diploma or equivalent or three years of practical experience.
- 2. Be in good physical condition.
- 3. Possess a valid Connecticut CDL Class B driver's license.
- 4. Have the ability to exercise a considerable amount of independent judgment.
- 5. Incumbents must be willing to accept assignment to emergency duties, including snow and ice removal, whenever his or her services are needed.
- 6. Some interpersonal skills, oral and written communication skills.
- 7. Be able to perform related tasks as assigned.

Physical requirements:

- 1. Applicants must have adequate strength, stamina, physical agility and visual and auditory, and must maintain physical fitness to perform the duties.
- 2. A physical exam will be required.
- Pre-employment drug and alcohol test must be completed prior to hiring date.
 NOTE: The City of Ansonia performs random drug testing on all Public Works employees.

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned:

- Assisting employee of higher grades in more skilled operation.
- Maintenance of building and grounds.
- Assisting Public Works refuse truck.
- Sidewalk cleaning during snow and ice operation.
- May be assigned a truck assignment.
- Performs other related duties as required.
- Should be able to lift or carry up to 50 pounds continuously and possibly up to 75 pounds up onto a shelf or truck from ground
- Pick up and repair curbing
- Picking up bulk on city streets
- Dump garbage cans
- Use of jackhammer, pick, and shovels
- Picking up 80-pound cement and/or ice bags
- Be able to shovel snow, city sidewalks
- Pick up concrete blocks
